- 1. Remove contents from box. Verify that all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before installation.
- 2. Locate factory tow hooks and remove them, saving the hardware removed.
- 3. The lower mounting brackets mount were the tow hooks used to be. Attach brackets with the hardware saved from above step.
- 4. Align the bumper guard with lower mounting brackets and attach with M14 hex head bolts, M14 flat washers, and M14 nylock nuts. Do not fully tighten at this time.
- 5. Locate the two plastic plugs located inside the upper bumper opening and remove. Take the support bracket and attach one side to these holes using the M6 X 25MM hex bolts, M6 flat washers, and M6 nylock nuts. Repeat this step for the other side. Do not tighten at this time.
- 6. Fasten the other end of the support bracket to the round hole located in each side of the upright vertical plates of the grille guard.
- 7. Level and adjust grille guard as needed. Tighten all fasteners at this time. Torque all M6 fasteners to 5-10 ft-lbs and all M14 fasteners to 40-45 ft-lbs.

FINISH PROTECTION

Westin products have a high quality finish that must be cared for like any other exposed finish on the vehicle. Protect the finish with a non-abrasive automotive wax, (e.g. Pure Carnauba) on a regular basis. The use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental, as the compounds scratch the finish and open it to corrosion.

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 Locate the two plastic plugs located inside the upper bumper opening and remove. Take the support bracket and attach one side to these holes using the M6 X 25MM hex bolts, M6 flat washers, and M6 nylock nuts. Repeat this step for the other side. Do not tighten at this time.
- 6. Fasten the other end of the support bracket to the round hole located in each side of the upright vertical plates of the grille guard.
- 7. Level and adjust grille guard as needed. Tighten all fasteners at this time. Torque all M6 fasteners to 5-10 ft-lbs and all M14 fasteners to 40-45 ft-lbs.

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
