



Removal of Stock System

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Remove the nuts from the studs holding the front flange together and disconnect the exhaust system. **Refer to Figures 1**.
- 3. Remove the hangers from the rubber insulators and remove the exhaust from the vehicle. **Refer to Figures 2 to 3**.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust

1. Install the **Extension Pipe** to the existing flange. Attach the hanger to the rubber insulator located on the frame. Leave the hardware loose enough for some adjustment. **Refer to Figure 4**. Note the **Extension Pipe** is the correct length for the crew cab long bed (167" wheelbase). The **Extension Pipe** will require trimming for other models. **Refer to the diagram below**.



2. Slide a **3 1/2**" Clamp onto the rear of the Extension Pipe. Install the Muffler onto the Extension Pipe. Refer to Figure 5.



4. Install the **Tail Pipe** hanger into the factory rubber insulator located directly above the hanger and attach to the Over Axle Pipe using a 3" Clamp. Refer to Figure 7.

- 5. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tip** to suit. Tighten the bolt located on the Exhaust Tip. Refer to Figure 8.
- 6. Align the exhaust as required before tightening clamps. Starting at the front of the exhaust tighten all clamps and connections. Check along the length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
