

STROKE, TURBO BACK, 4" SINGLE SIDE

PLEASE READ BEFORE STARTING INSTALATION

While MBRP Inc. has made every effort to ensure that all components of this system are of superior quality and properly packaged it is the installer's responsibility to ensure the following before removal of the factory exhaust:

- that ALL components shown above are present.
- that ALL mating components fit together.
- that there are no damaged components.
- that the system you have purchased is appropriate for your vehicle year, model and configuration.
- that the system will not interfere with any modifications previously installed or planned.
- that you have read and understand these instructions.

If you have any questions or are uncertain about any aspect of the installation of this system to your vehicle please contact your dealer before commencing installation.



Removal of stock system:

- 1. Loosen the nut on the band clamp located behind the catalytic converter using a 15mm wrench or socket.
- If a hoist is being used for the installation, the original exhaust system can be removed in one piece by removing the passenger side shock. If a hoist is not being used the tail pipe must be cut behind the muffler to be removed.
- 3. Remove the muffler and tail pipe from the OEM rubber hangers and separate the stock exhaust at the slip joint located behind the catalytic converter and remove the muffler and tail pipe from under the truck. Reinstall the passenger side shock.
- 4. Remove the catalytic converter by removing the two nuts holding the inlet flange together using a 15mm wrench or socket.
- 5. Remove the down pipe from the turbo by removing the band clamp using an 11mm socket. Retain the band clamp for the installation of the new down pipe. Cut the down pipe in front of the transmission cross member to remove. (Note: The stock down pipe can be removed in one piece by removing the transmission cross member. It is recommended that this only be done by qualified, trained professionals using tools and equipment designed to safely carry out this procedure.)

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

- 1. Install the Down Pipe in the same position as the stock down pipe and attach the flared end to the turbo using the stock band clamp. Do not fully tighten until all components are in place.
- 2. Attach the Mid Pipe to the Down Pipe and place the hanger into the factory rubber insulator located on the frame.
- 3. Install the Extension Pipe on to the Mid Pipe.
- 4. Install the Muffler over the Extension Pipe securing it with the 4" Band Hanger Clamp. Install the hanger into the OEM hanger located at the inlet of the muffler.

- 5. Install the Over-Axle Pipe from the rear of the truck, over the axle and attach to the outlet of the Muffler securing it using one of the 4" Band Clamps. Install the hangers into the OEM rubber hangers located above the outlet of the Muffler.
- 6. Install the Tail Pipe on to the Over-Axle Pipe securing it using the remaining 4" Band Clamp. Install the hanger into the OEM hanger.
- 7. Install the provided Clamp around the pipes where required. Adjust the Tail Pipe and check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
- 8. Ensure that the exhaust is in place before tightening clamps. Start at the front of the exhaust system and begin tightening all connections.
- 9. Install and adjust the Tip to suit.
