






STEP 1 Remove fan cover by removing plastic push rivets. Next remove factory grille shell by firmly pulling out on the 6 clips at each location shown above.



STEP 2 Next tape off all painted or chrome areas using masking tape to protect the finish of the grille shell during installation.



STEP 4 Sand the cut areas smooth.




STEP 5 Center the Billet Grill and make sure the front edge of the grille shell and the billet grille are flush as shown.


- 14 #8 x 5/8" Blk. Phil. Pan head Screw
- 6 #8 x 3/8" Brite Phil. Pan head Screw
- 14 U-Clips
- 2 Short Angle brkts.
- 4 Long Z-brkts.
- 2 Short Z-brkts.
- 2 Long Angle brkts. ∟



STEP 3 Cut out the cross hatch area (shown in Red). On the top & bottom portions of the grille shell.



STEP 6 Attach the bracket as shown above.



STEP 7 Mark the locations of holes in the mounting tabs and drill a 3/32" hole.

NOTE: *CAUTION* Be extremely carefull to ONLY drill thru the first layer of plastic, otherwise you could drill thru the front of your grille shell. Use the 3/8" brite screws to attach the 6 inner brackets to the grille shell also note that brackets #2 have a slightly longer end than bracket #3. **STEP 8** Remove masking tape and reinstall grille shell. NOTE: Please adjust horizontal blades if irregular. This is the result of shipping and handling outside of Carriage Work's control.

Also Carriage Works Inc. recommends applying a high quality automotive wax to maintain the original appearance.
