Hardware

- 2 Brackets
- 2 Braclets \angle
- 8 U-clips
- 8 #8 x 5/8" Phil pan head screws



Open hood and remove (8) plastic rivets located across the top of the core support shown above in (Blue).



Starting with the drivers side corner of vehcile, pull straight up on the stock grille shell to release. Then repeat for the passenger side. Gille shell will be free at this point.



Remove (11) Phil head screws from the backside of the stock grille shell. The black plastic backing will be separated from the Front Chome.



Snap chrome portion of stock grille shell back in stock location. Using a scribe mark the location of the stock screw mounting location where it meets vehicle.



Re-place all of the plastic rivets that were removed from step 1.



Using a scribe mark the location of the stock screw mounting location where it meets vehicle. Note: You will need to Hold shell in correct location as shown above before marking. Also when marking hole, mark as far to the outside as you can before marking. Remove stock chome section from vehcile.

Then using a 3/16" drill bit, drill in the just

Place supplied U-clips on the short ends of the supplied brackets as shown above.



Re-place the chome section. Then attach chome section using the supplied #8 x 5/8" Phil head screws in the just marked locations as shown above. NOTE: Just snug the screws up--Do Not Over-tighten.



Attach the brackets to billet grille using supplied #8 x 5/8" phil head screws as shown above.



Place the billet grille into the opening and center. Using a 90° scribe reach thru the front of the billet grille and mark the holes in the bottom brackets as shown above. Then mark the holes for the top brackets. After marking remove brakeets from billet grille



Using a 3/16" drill bit, drill in the just marked locations.



Place supplied U-clips on bottom of the grille shell opening shown above in (Blue). Using the supplied Square tabs place the supplied U-clips on each of the tabs shown above in (Green).



Attach bottom brackets to U-clips located on bottom of grille shell opening (Ref. step 13 Blue) using supplied #8 x 5/8" Phil pan head screws. Attach top brackets using the square tabs (Ref. step 13 Green). Square tabs go on the underside and attach using #8 x 5/8" Phil pan head screw as shown above.



After brackets are attached



Attach billet grille to brackets using the supplied #8 x 5/8" Phil pan head screws.

For installation of billet grilles that require cutting of the stock shell, proper tools, knowledge and skill are needed.
