INSTALLATION STEPS

- NO DRILLING REQUIRED

- 1. Lower the spare tire before beginning hitch installation. **Note:** Spare will be reinstalled after hitch installation.
- 2. Insert the 1/2-13 x 1 3/4" carriage bolts and the SP1 spacers through the holes in the frame rails.
- 3. Raise the hitch into position by aligning the carriage bolts with the holes in the hitch and secure with 1/2" flange nuts.
- 4. Torque all hardware to 110 ft-lbs.
- 5. Reinstall the spare tire. **Note**: After the hitch is installed you may need to push the spare tire toward the front of the truck to provide clearance between the tire and the hitch.
