**SAFETY WARNING** BDS Suspension Co. recommends this system be installed by a professional technician. In addition to these instructions, professional knowledge of disassembly/ reassembly procedures and post installation checks must be known.

### PRE-INSTALLATION NOTES

1. Special literature required: OE Service Manual for model/year of vehicle. Refer to manual for proper disassembly/ reassembly procedures of OE and related components.
2. Adhere to recommendations when replacement fasteners, retainers and keepers are called out in the OE manual.
3. Secure and properly block vehicle prior to installation of BDS Suspension components. Always wear safety glasses when using power tools.
4. To properly perform installation, you must use two (2) large C-clamps or a large vise to contain the elastic potential energy in a leaf spring when the center bolt is removed.

### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

5. Remove the distributor cap to avoid damage.
6. Place a jack under the transfer case crossmember and remove the frame to cross member bolts.
7. Carefully lower the transfer case so the crossmember is about 1" below the frame on both sides.
8. Install the supplied transfer case spacers between the crossmember and frame. Install the new bolts and nuts supplied and tighten to specification.
9. Install the distributor cap.
10. Inspect the fasteners for tightness periodically.
