

- 1. Remove the driver's side tie rod assembly according to the manufacturer's recommendations.
- 2. Remove the boot from the rack and pinion housing.
- 3. Turn the steering wheel fully to the right so that the steering rack (shaft) retracts into the (bore).
- 4. Remove the black plastic retainer from the inner bore and discard.
- 5. Lubricate the bushing (O-ring) and inner tapered portion of the (bore).
- 6. Align the (lobe) portion of the Bronc bushing with the housing and insert into the bore by hand, making sure to engage the .100" / 2.5 mm (step) of the bushing into the housing. The (lobe) should be oriented to the 10 o'clock position with the part number facing out.
- 7. Using the blue installation (driver), tap the bushing slightly into the bore about .125" / 7mm.
- 8. Using the rack shaft as an alignment guide, drive the bushing in using the blue installation driver.
- 9. Install the (snap ring) and make sure that it is seated into the bore. Use the installation driver if necessary.
- 10. Reinstall the tie rod assembly according to the manufacture's recommendations.



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
