


- 1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED.




(Fig 1) Driver/Left Front Mounting Location Pictured

- 2. Starting on the driver side front of the vehicle, remove the existing (2) factory bolts, (or plastic plugs), on the side panel located by the front tire opening, (**Figure 1**). This will be the mounting location for the driver side front Mounting Bracket.
- 3. Select the driver side Front Bracket, (Figure 2). Attach the Bracket to the vehicle using the included (2) 8mm x 30mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Figure 3). Do not tighten hardware at this time.
- 4. Move along the side panel to the next mounting location closest to the front Bracket, (Figure 4). Repeat Step 2 & 3 to install the driver side Center Bracket, (Figures 5 & 6).


(Fig 7) Driver/Left rear Bracket

- 5. Next, move to the last mounting location at the back of the cab. Select the driver side Rear Bracket, (Figure 7). Repeat Steps 2 & 3 to install the rear Bracket, (Figure 8). IMPORTANT: There are (4) mounting locations along the side of the vehicle. Installation will use the 1st, 2nd and 4th mounting locations only.
- 6. Select the Running Board. Slip (8) M6 T-Bolts into each bottom channel (Figure 9). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (3) Mounting Brackets. IMPORTANT: Do not slide the Running Board on the Brackets or damage to the finish may result. Attach the Running Board to the Mounting Brackets with (2) M6 T-bolts,(2)M6 flat washers and (2)M6 nylon lock nuts (Figure 10). Do not tighten hardware.
- 7. Level and adjust the Running Board properly and tighten all hardware. NOTE: Torque all M6 nylon lock nuts to 7 lb-ft.
- **8.** Repeat **Steps 2—7** for passenger side installation.
- **9.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.


For Polished Finishes: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Board.

For black finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.
