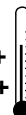

Preparation Before Painting / Installation

- A trial fit is recommended to ensure proper positioning and fit.
- Check fit of parts before painting as we will not accept the return of modified or painted parts.
- Wash and dry your vehicle to remove any debris and/or dirt from the installation area.
- **Ensure vehicle surface and part are above 60°F (15°C) prior to installation.**

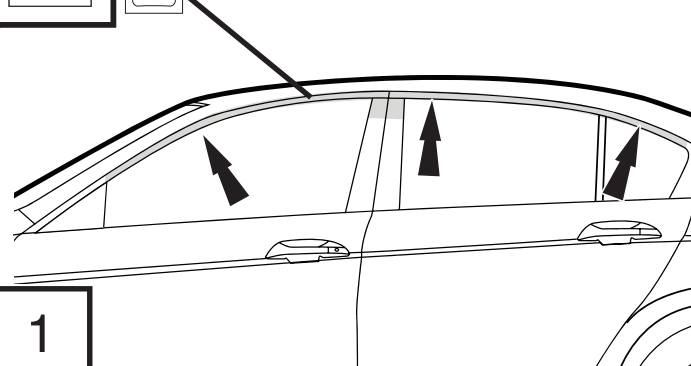


Installation Steps

Clean the window frames with an alcohol pad and dry with a soft cloth.

Peel back 2" (5cm) of tape liner from rear end of top flange. Ensure free end is accessible. Remove tape liner from small tab.

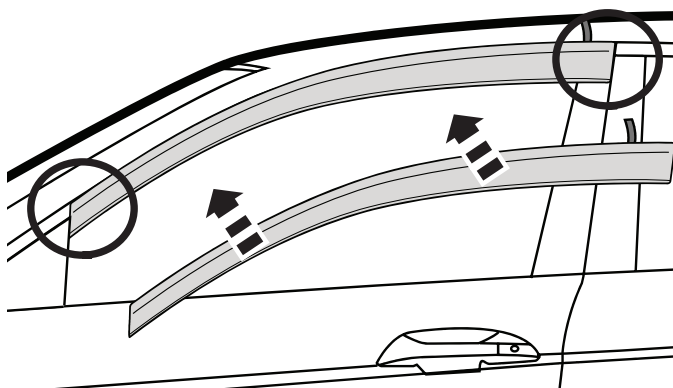

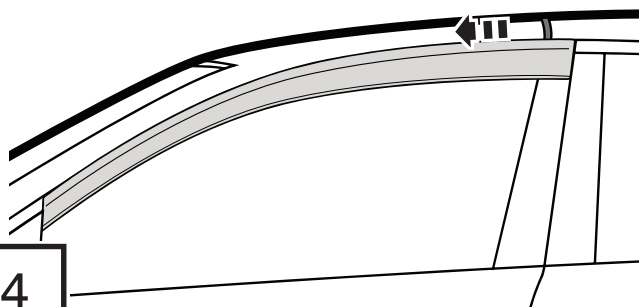
Align the Front Visor on the outside of the door frame.

Gently press the exposed areas of tape against the surface and verify position. With the Front Visor in its final position, remove the remaining tape liner by pulling on free end.

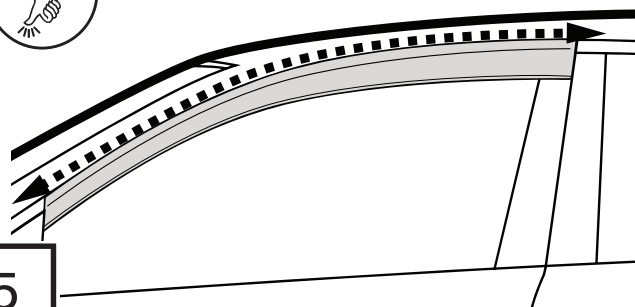

Apply pressure along all flanges to ensure proper adhesion of tape.



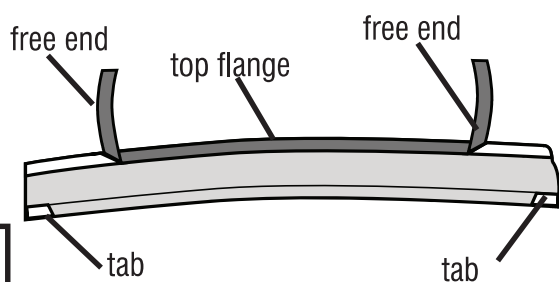

4 Piece Set

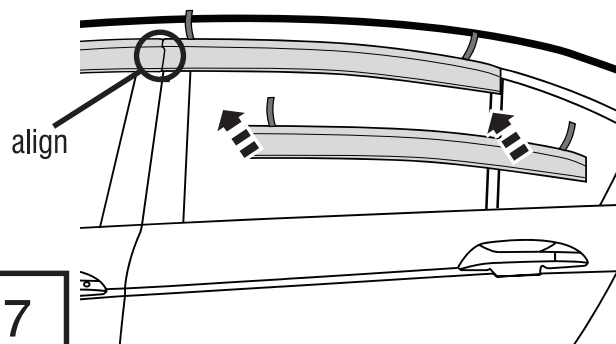
Peel back 2" (5cm) of tape liner from each end of top flange. Remove tape liner from tabs if present.

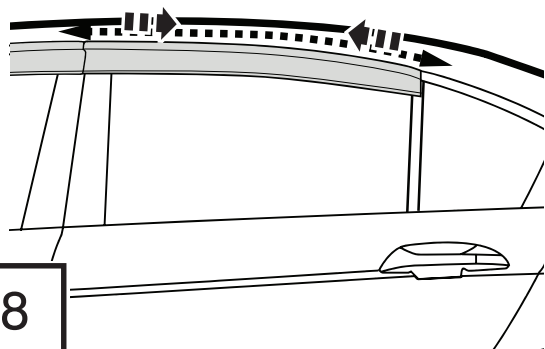
Align the deflector with the edge of front and rear doors.

Gently press the exposed areas of tape against the surface and verify position. With the Rear Visor in its final position, remove the remaining tape liner by pulling on free ends.

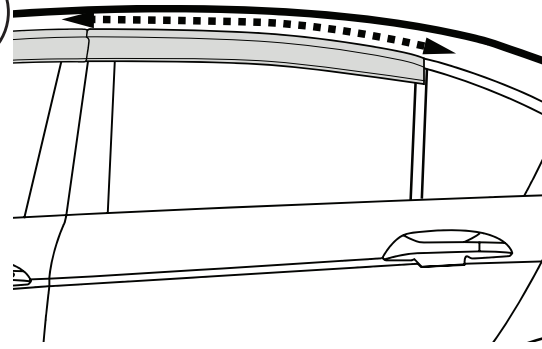

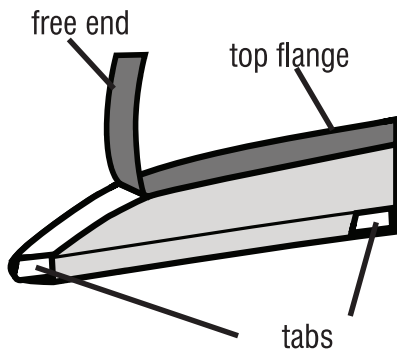

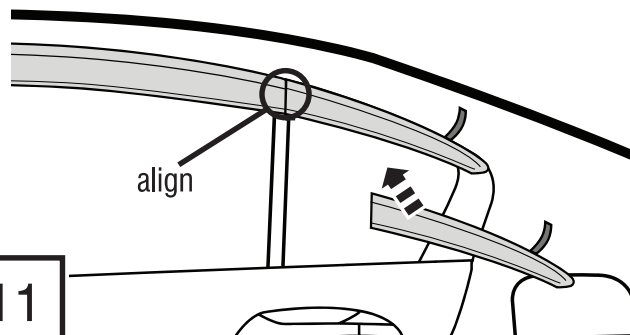
6 Piece Set

Peel back 2" (5cm) of tape liner from each end of top flange. Remove tape liner from tabs.



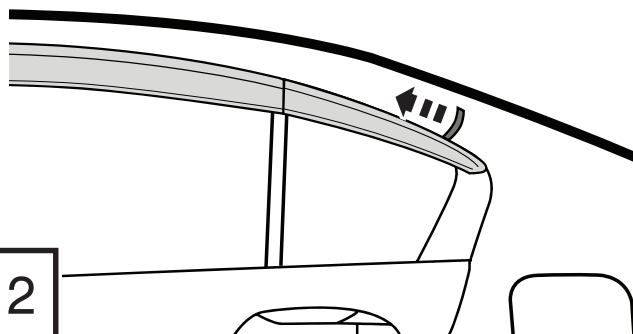

Align the deflector on the outside of the door frame. Align the front of the Extended Rear Visor parallel to the previously installed Rear Visor.



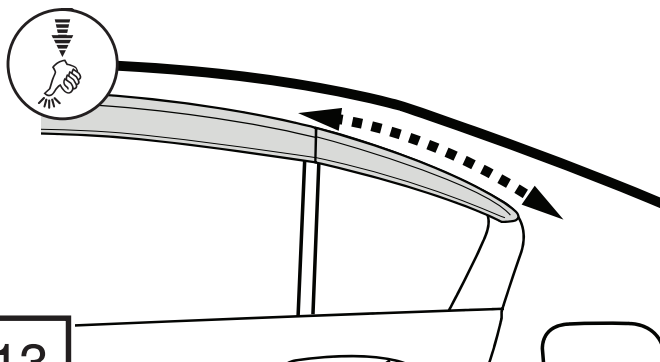

Gently press the exposed areas of tape against the surface and verify position. With the visor in its final position, remove the remaining tape liner by pulling on free ends.

Apply pressure along all flanges to ensure proper adhesion of tape.

Repeat **Steps 1 - 13** for opposite side.
