




VEHICLE PREPARATION:


It is important that all areas where the wheel wells mount are clean and free of debris prior to installing.




Start on the driver side by removing the fasteners and nuts that hold the support rods to the bottom of the wheel fender using a ratchet with 10mm socket and 13mm wrench for front and rear.




Remove the plastic protector by removing the push pins using a flat tool.



Start on the driver side by setting the driver side wheel well (A) marked as (DS) inside the inner



Tuck the bottom sides of the lower part of the wheel well liner behind the metal lip of truck's fender and then tuck the upper part.




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## 99-08 FORD F250/350

Locate the (4) pre-drilled holes in the liner and insert a small Christmas tree fastener (E) in each hole and into the pre-existing holes in the sheet metal.




**Note:** Models 1999-2004 only require (3) small Christmas tree fasteners (E).

Note: Models 2005-2008: Locate the (2) pre-drilled holes near the bottom section of the liner and insert a medium Christmas tree fastener (D) through each hole in the liner and into the pre-existing holes in the sheet metal frame.



**Note:** For trucks 1999-2004, step 9 is not necessary.

**Note:** Make sure cable **3** is in front of the liner.



Re-install the fasteners and nuts you saved from step 3 that hold the support rods to the bottom of the wheel fender using a ratchet with 10mm socket and 13mm wrench for the front and rear.

side wheel well (B) marked (PS).

Locate the (2) pre-drilled holes near the bottom section of the liner and insert a large Christmas tree fastener (C) through each hole in the liner and into the pre-existing holes in the sheet metal frame.
