




Start on the left hand side by setting the driver 4




Make sure that the cab part of the lower wheel well liner is tucked behind the metal lip of truck's fender before installing the two self-tapping screws (C) in positions 1 and 2. Use drill with 5/16" socket to insert screws through existing holes in liner into the sheet metal.



6 Make sure that the tail part of the lower wheel well liner is tucked behind the metal lip of truck's fender before installing the two self-tapping screws (C) in positions 3 and 4. Use drill with 5/16" socket to insert screws through existing holes in liner into the sheet metal.



Tuck the upper part of the wheel well liner behind the rest of the metal lip of the truck's fender. Locate the three holes in the upper part of the wheel well liner and make sure they align with the three pre-drilled holes in the top edge of the truck's fender (1,2,3). Use 3 of the push pins (D)



Repeat steps 3-7 on the passenger side when installing the passenger side wheel well (B).
