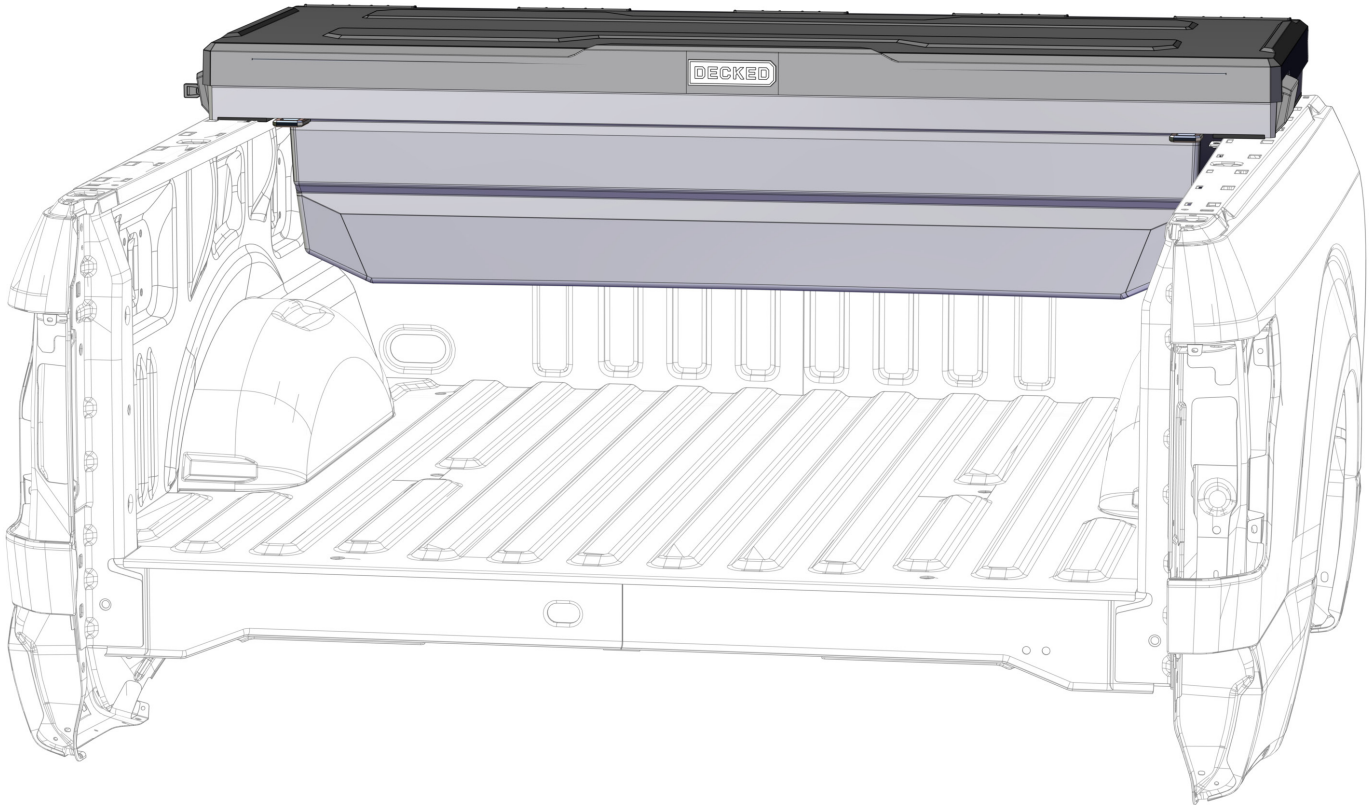

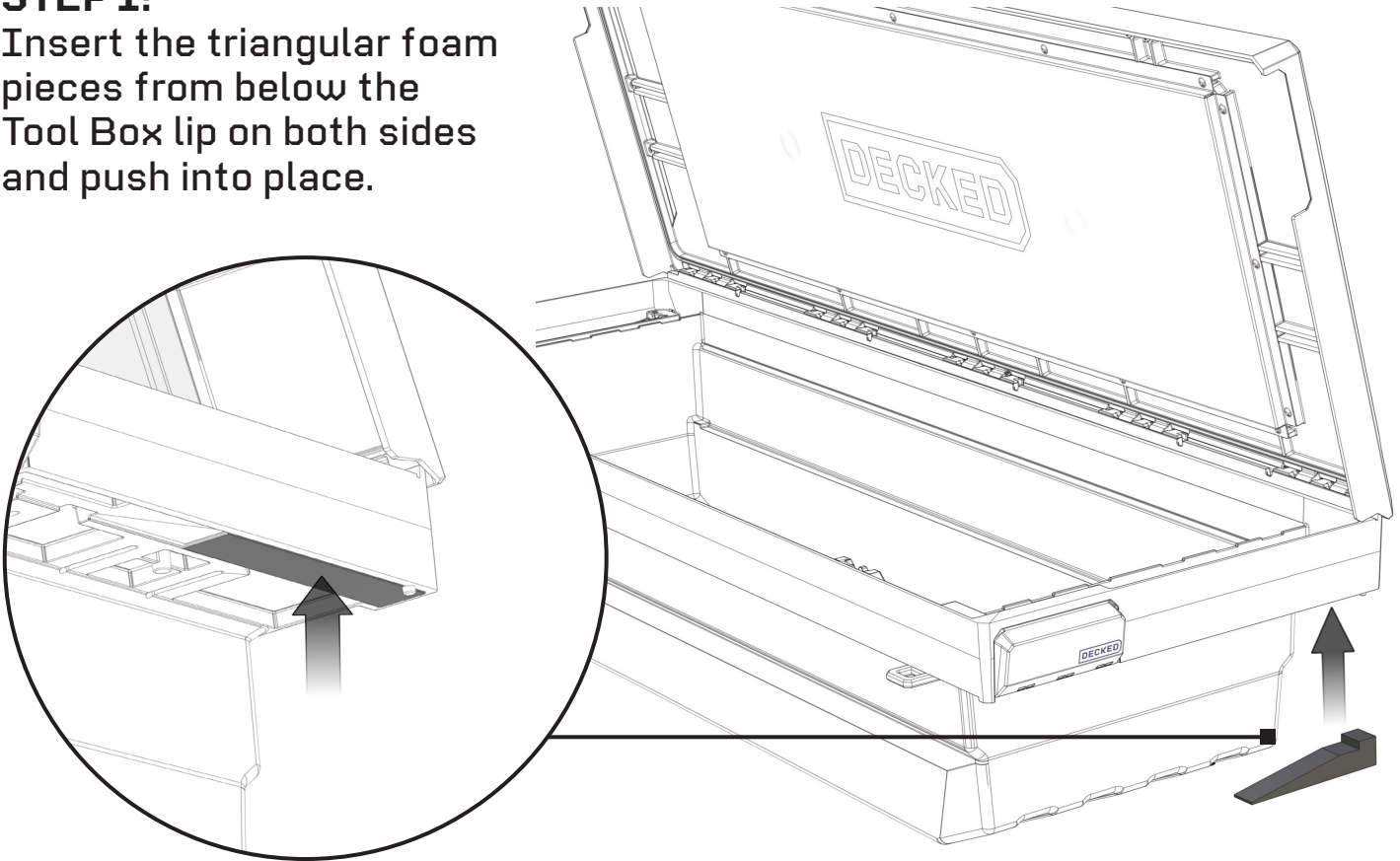
TOOLS NEEDED:

- 3/8" deep well socket (or use extender)
- Ratchet

DECKED TOOL BOX INSTALLATION

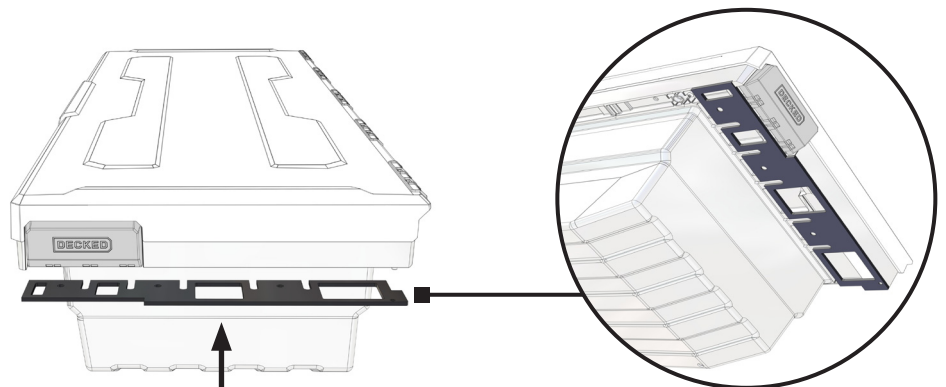
STEP 1:

Insert the triangular foam pieces from below the Tool Box lip on both sides and push into place.



STEP 2:

Align and press a rubber bed rail pad up into the recessed areas under the overhang on both sides of the Tool Box.

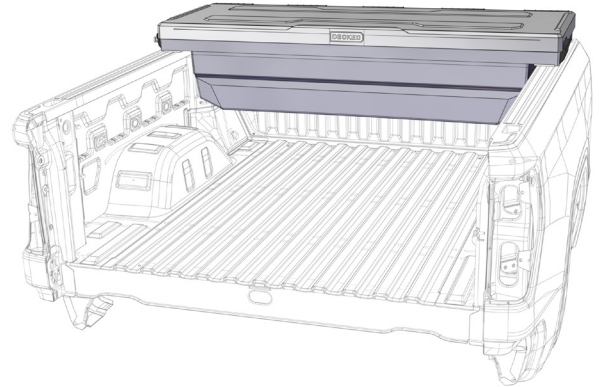
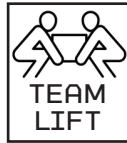


DECKED TOOL BOX INSTALLATION

STEP 3:

Unless you've experienced radiation exposure (allowing you to mutate into The Hulk) grab a friend to help you lift the Tool Box and place on top of the bed rails.

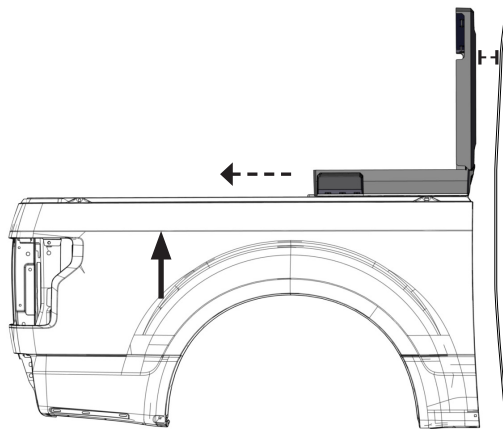
Center the Tool Box L-R between the bed rails keeping the rubber pads in place.



STEP 4:

Open the lid to make sure there is adequate distance (at least 2") between the Tool Box lid and any cab mounted cameras, lights or other important bits.

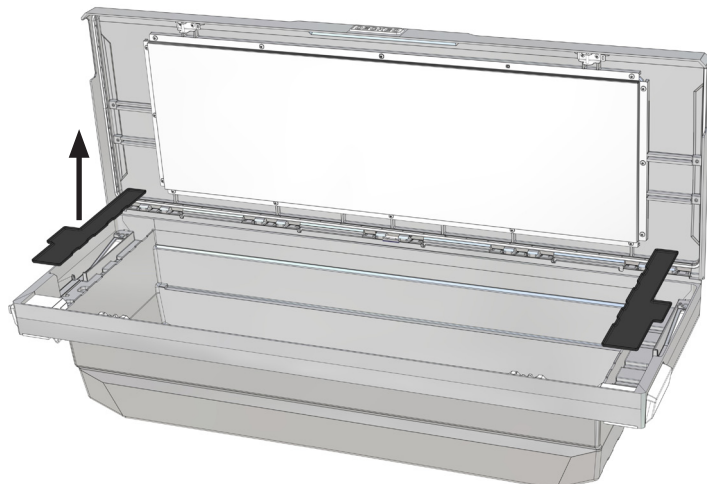
Shift the Tool Box toward the tailgate as needed to ensure correct positioning.



← WARNING
PROTECT YOUR TECH! KEEP AT LEAST A DISTANCE OF 2" BETWEEN TOOL BOX LID AND BACKUP CAMERA/LIGHTS

STEP 5:

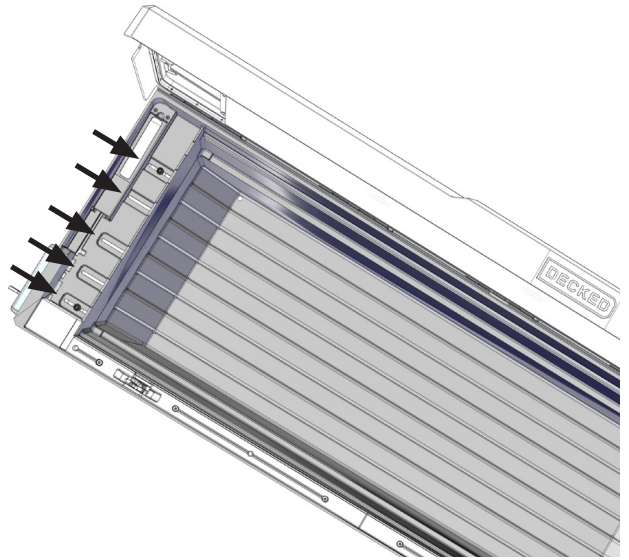
Remove the rubber tool tray mats to expose the mounting locations.



STEP 6:

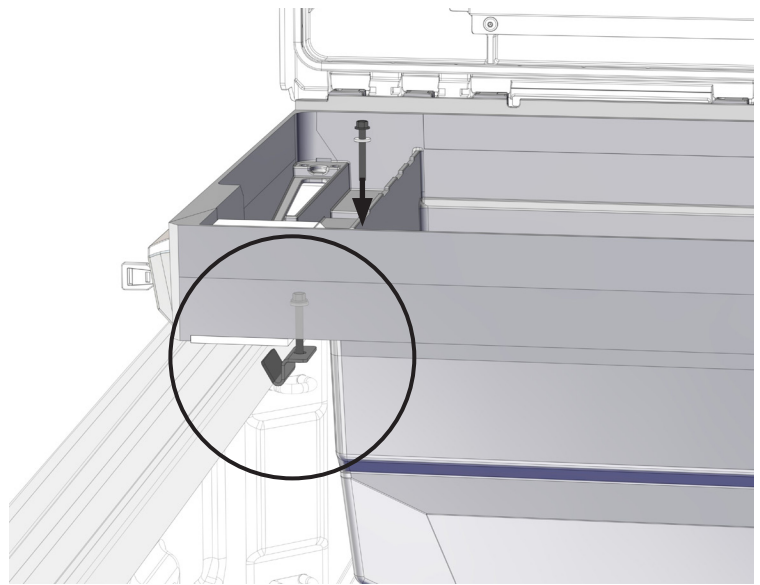
There are five installation locations on each side of the Tool Box. Install (2) bed rail clamps on each side of the Tool Box using one location as close to the tailgate as possible and one location as close to the cab as possible.

NOTE: Outermost clamp locations vary per vehicle depending on the topology of the bed rails.



STEP 7:

Secure clamps under the bed rail with bolts and washers from inside the Tool Box. Tighten all four bolts to 60 in-lb.



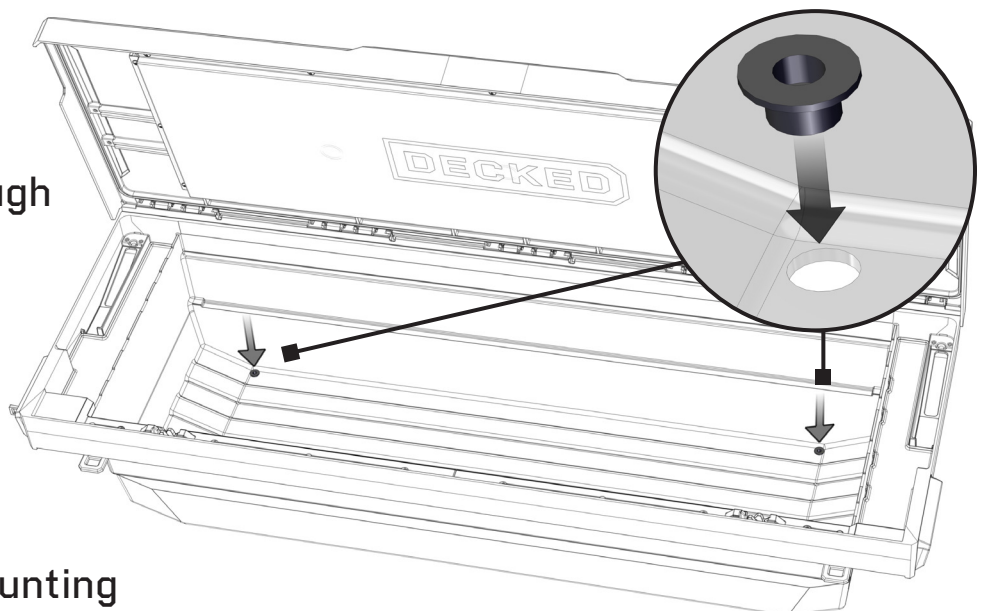
STEP 8:

Open the Tool box lid.

From inside the tub, push a rubber plug through each drain hole.

STEP 9:

Test tightness by closing Tool Box lid and trying to shift the Tool Box L-R and front to back. Check mounting brackets and bolts often to ensure they are secure.

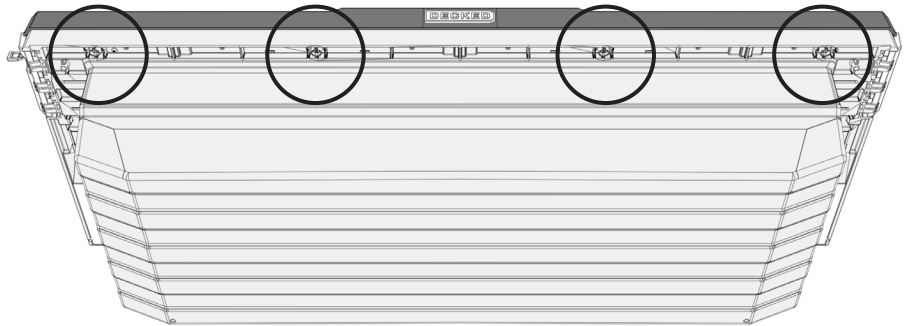


DECKED D-RING CARGO TIE DOWNS

TOOLS NEEDED:

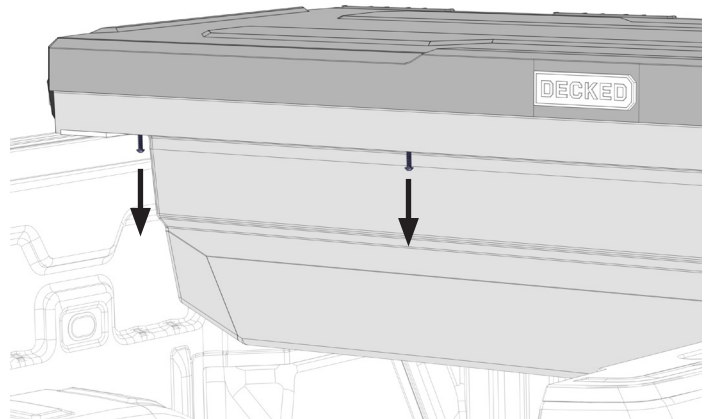
- 3/16" hex key
- 5/32" hex key

There are four D-Ring Cargo Tie Down positions available. We included two D-Ring Cargo Tie Downs and hardware. Additional D-Rings are available on our website.



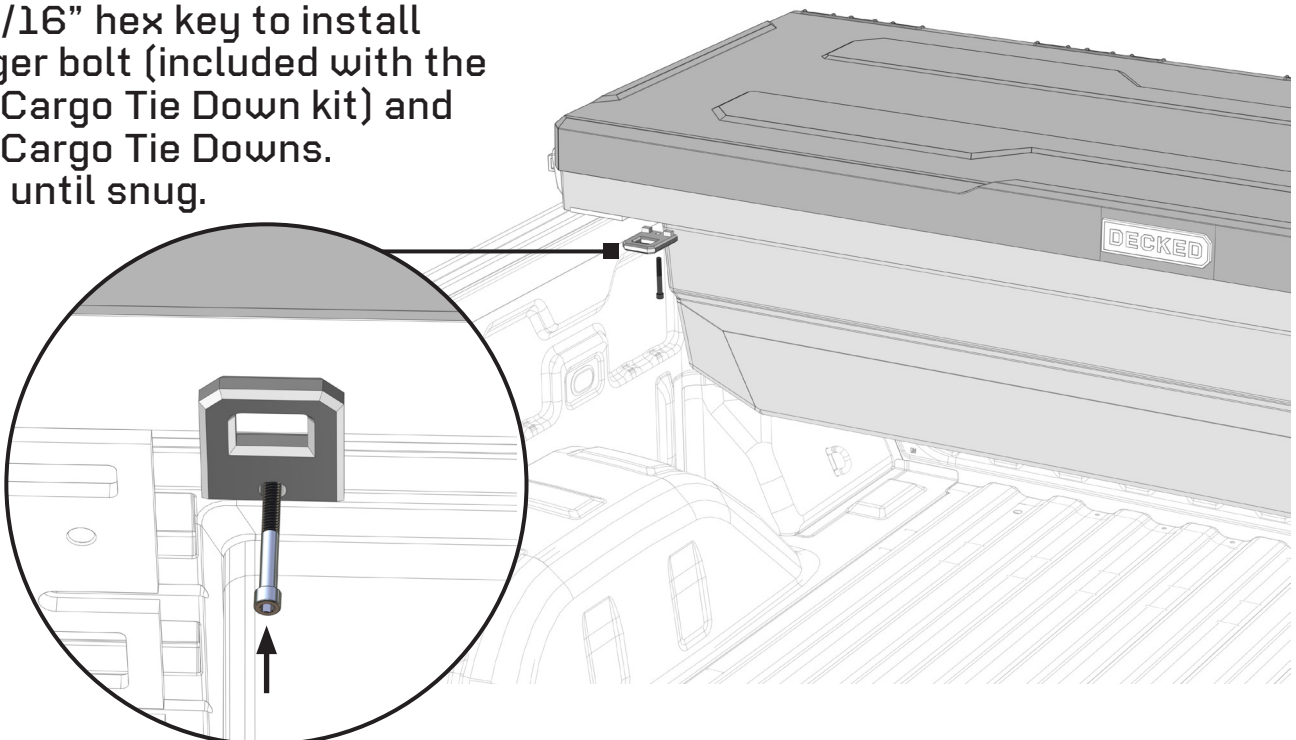
STEP 1:

Use a 5/32" hex key to remove the existing bolt in the desired D-Ring Cargo Tie Down install location. This bolt will not be reused.



STEP 2:

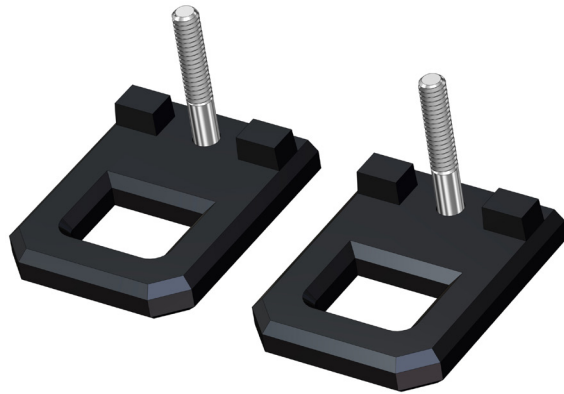
Use a 3/16" hex key to install the longer bolt (included with the D-Ring Cargo Tie Down kit) and D-Ring Cargo Tie Downs. Tighten until snug.

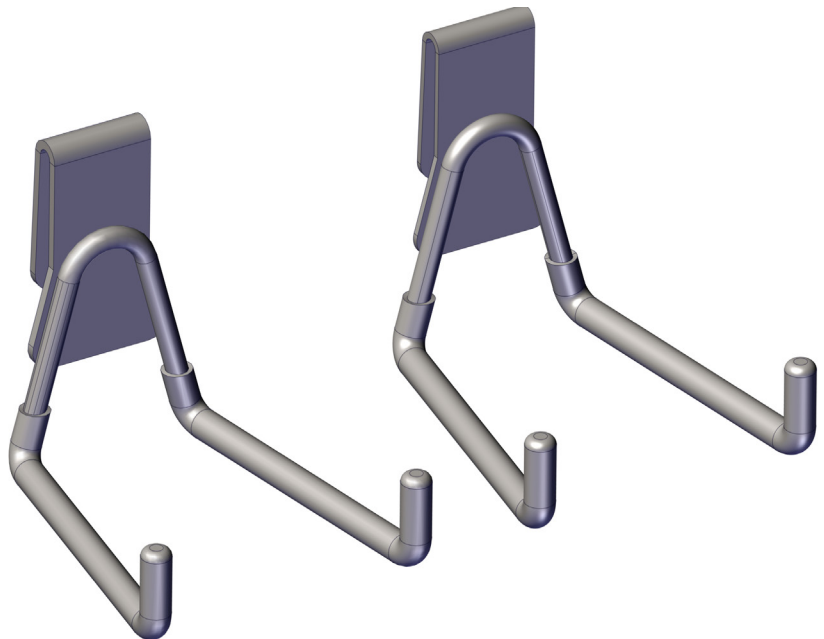
