USER SAFETY CAUTION

During installation, be mindful of the potential for sharp edges on the product or vehicle. Taking proper safety precautions helps ensure a safe and smooth installation process.

Always wear protective gloves and handle components with care to reduce the risk of injury.



TEMPERATURE SURFACE CAUTION

During high temperatures or extended sun exposure, surfaces of this product may become hot to the touch, posing a risk of burns or injury. Use caution when handling the product in hot weather and allow time for it to cool before contact.


Always check surface temperature before use to ensure safe handling conditions.



FASTENER TORQUE CAUTION

All fasteners must be tightened to the specified torque values provided in the installation instructions to ensure proper fit and safe operation of the tonneau cover. Under- or over-tightening can lead to product failure, potential damage to your vehicle, injury, or safety hazards while driving.

Always use a calibrated torque wrench and follow the specifications in the installation instructions.



PINCH POINT SAFETY CAUTION

This tonneau cover may create pinch points when closing or operating near solid surfaces such as the truck bed rails or tailgate. To prevent injury, keep hands, fingers, and other body parts clear of moving parts during operation.

Always operate the cover slowly and with caution to ensure safe and proper use.



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ENTRAPMENT SAFETY WARNING

This tonneau cover does not feature a manual release mechanism from inside the truck bed. To prevent the risk of entrapment, never allow anyone to be inside the bed of the truck when the cover is closed.

Always ensure the area is clear before closing the cover, and keep the cover securely latched when not in use to avoid accidental closure.




CARGO TRANSPORT WARNING

Do not attempt to close the tonneau cover over cargo that is taller than the depth of the truck bed.


Never force the cover to close improperly.

Forcing the cover can:

- Prevent the cover from lying flat and latching securely.
- Damage the cover's hinge and cause the cover to kink.
- Damage the rear tail panel and cause it to become detached.




NOTE: It is important that all areas where the bed cover mounts are clean and free of debris prior to installing.



PARTS INCLUDED IN YOUR KIT


- A** Cover assembly
- B** 2x Cab clamp brackets
- C** 2x Cab slide blocks
- D** 4x Cab Torx screws
- E** 1x Striker bracket, driver side
- F** 1x Striker bracket, passenger side

- H** 4x T-30 Torx screws with washers




TOOLS PROVIDED

- Torx wrench - T-20
- Torx wrench - T-27
- Hex wrench - 2.5MM


- 1** Place the folded, assembled bed cover (A) over the cab end of the truck box.



- 2** Unfold the bed cover (A) fully and adjust position over the truck bed for proper front (cab) and rear (tailgate) alignment. When positioned front and back, the tailgate seal should contact the tailgate with the first two fins.




- 3** Carefully refold the bed cover (A) without shifting its position on the truck bed.





4 WITHOUT CARGO RAILS

Hook the jaw of the cab clamps under the truck bed rails. Tighten the knobs until the jaw contacts the rails, then tighten an additional two turns. Do this for both sides of the truck bed.




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
5 WITH CARGO RAILS

If there are cargo rail end caps remove the rear (tailgate) caps. Remove any tie-downs. Install the cab slide block (C) into the (tailgate) end of the cargo rail. Position the slide block near the cab. Do this for both sides of the bed. Reinstall all tie-downs and end caps.




6 WITH CARGO RAILS

Align the cab clamp bracket (B) with the cab clamp of the bed cover. Use the Torx screws (D) to mount the cab clamp bracket (B) to the cab slide block (C). Tighten the screws with the T-27 Torx tool to 3.5 ft-lbs (4.7 Nm). Do this for both sides of the truck.




7 WITH CARGO RAILS

Hook the cab clamp under the cab clamp bracket (B) and tighten the T-handle until it contacts the bracket (B), then tighten two more turns. Do this for both sides of the truck bed.





With the tailgate open and the front (cab) clamps secure, completely close the bed cover (A).




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
If the bed rail caps are not trimmed in the rear (tailgate) section, cut using the scribed lines to expose the area shown.




- 10** At the tailgate, attach the striker brackets (E & F) to the truck bed with the slide block (G) placed in between using the T-30 Torx screws with washers (H). Note that there is a driver side (E) and a passenger side (F) bracket. They are oriented as shown with the loop towards the tailgate.



- 11** Close the tailgate and close the cover (A). Check that the cover is parallel and square with the truck bed and bed rails. If not parallel, adjust the cover from side to side.




- 12** Adjustments and tightening of the latch assembly is required.



The bed cover latch assemblies and rotary knob come from the factory only partially tightened to allow installation adjustments. Both latches and rotary knob will require adjustment and final tightening. **Only use the hand tools provided, do not use power tools.**

Lower the rear of the bed cover and loosen the screws on both latch assemblies and the rotary knob. Rotate the knob to locate the screws. Adjust the position of each latch so that they engage with the striker brackets, (Fig. 1). With the latches adjusted, from underneath the cover, use the provided T-20 Torx wrench to tighten the two screws, (Fig. 2) so the latch does not move in the channel. Repeat on the other side



The cables come routed through the barrel clamps of the rotary knob. Adjust the position of the rotary knob so that the cable from the driver side latch can be inserted through the barrel clamp leaving 3/4" - 1" of cable extending through the barrel clamp without turning the knob, for future adjustments (Fig. 3).





Rotate the rotary knob until you see the flat head screws. Tighten the two screws using the provided Torx T-20 wrench, (Fig. 3) so the knob does not move in the channel. Repeat on the other side.

Next, tighten the barrel clamp set screws, (Fig. 4) with the provided 2.5mm hex key to secure the latch cables. Rotate the rotary knob, (Fig. 4) to verify that the latches disengage from the striker brackets.


Close the cover, then double-check that it is secure and tight to the truck bed by gently lifting the corners to ensure the mechanisms are engaged.






Opening the cover

Open the cover by twisting the rotary knob and lifting the cover.



Securing the cover

To drive with the cover open, fold the cover forward to the cab and fasten **BOTH** straps in the middle section to the front rail. Check that the straps are tight, and pull the strap end if too loose. **FAILURE TO DO SO COULD RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE COVER AND TRUCK.**



! IMPORTANT

Re-tighten the front/cab clamps and tethers after the first week of driving the vehicle. Also periodically check the clamps and tethers to ensure they are secure.

Closed/Extended Position – Bed cover must be completely secured by all four (4) clamps.

Open/Folded Position – Bed cover must be completely folded up (all panels) and secured at the cab with the provided buckles straps and with both tethers attached.


Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.



Do NOT allow the vehicle to be towed backwards without first removing the cover from the vehicle.






Remove any snow or foreign matter before folding the bed cover.

LIMITED WARRANTY

WARRANTY COVERAGE

This truck bed cover is warranted against defects in materials or workmanship as follows. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged in an accident, or due to neglect, unforeseeable use, improper installation, improper servicing, or other cause not arising out of defects in material or workmanship.

The truck bed cover carries a limited warranty for five (5) years from the original date of purchase, subject to the terms below.

WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE

The warranty is to the initial owner purchasing the truck bed cover and it is not transferrable to a subsequent end user. Proof of purchase may be required to enforce these warranty rights.

WARRANTY CONDITIONS

Failure to follow these care and use instructions will void the warranty.

- Clean with mild automotive soap and water only.
- Cover must be secured at all points when vehicle is in motion. When not fully extended, cover must be completely folded up and secured at the cab with the provided buckle straps and tethers attached. Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.
- Check all clamps and retention mechanisms for tightness after a week of driving following installation (or re-installation) of the cover and periodically thereafter.
- Before opening, cover must be free of all foreign materials including snow and ice.
- Do NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.

WARRANTY PERFORMANCE

If all warranty conditions are met, a defective truck bed cover or hardware component will either be repaired or replaced (at our option). We reserve the right, for any warranty, to substitute a newer model or bed cover having similar form and function, to offer a warranty discount on an entire replacement system, and/or provide remedies other than those mentioned in this document.

WARRANTY PROCESS

A Return Authorization number must be obtained from our Customer Service Department prior to returning any product. We may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. Other than postage or shipping charges, no charge will be made for repair or replacement under this warranty.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. As an owner, you may also have additional rights and remedies under the laws of your state.

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

Warranty registration must be on file and/or proof of original purchase (detailed and dated receipt) required for warranty to be effective.
