## **TEMPERATURE SURFACE CAUTION**



# **FASTENER TORQUE CAUTION**



Under- or over-tightening can lead to product failure, potential damage to your vehicle, injury, or safety hazards while driving.





# **PINCH POINT SAFETY CAUTION**

This tonneau cover may create pinch points when closing or operating near solid surfaces such as the truck bed rails or tailgate. To prevent injury, keep hands, fingers, and other body parts clear of moving parts during operation.

## **ENTRAPMENT SAFETY WARNING**

This tonneau cover does not feature a manual release mechanism from inside the truck bed. To prevent the risk of entrapment, never allow anyone to be inside the bed of the truck when the cover is closed.

Always ensure the area is clear before closing the cover, and keep the cover securely latched when not in use to avoid accidental closure.



# **CARGO TRANSPORT WARNING**

Do not attempt to close the tonneau cover over cargo that is taller than the depth of the truck bed.

Never force the cover to close improperly.

#### Forcing the cover can:

- Prevent the cover from lying flat and latching securely.
- Damage the cover's hinge and cause the cover to kink.
- Damage the rear tail panel and cause it to become detached.































































The tethers come installed on the bed cover hinge with a clamp at the other end. Install the clamp end by sliding the clamp onto the adapter rail (H). Make sure the clamp is positioned as far up onto the rail as possible. Firmly hand tighten the knobs. Install the tethers on both sides of the cover.




Close the tailgate and unfold the cover. Check that the cover is parallel and square with the truck bed and bed rails. If not parallel or square, open the cover and loosen the cab clamps to reposition the cover. Adjust and re-tighten both clamps.




Install the striker bracket (B) by loosening the Torx screws (E) until there is enough space for the backing plate (C) to fit behind the adapter rail (H) while the striker bracket plate (B) fits on the front of the adapter rail (H).



Close the cover (A) and align the striker bracket (B) with the bed cover latch. Push down on the cover while tightening the Torx screws (E)to 3,ft-lbs (4 Nm).



# Adjustments and tightening of the latch assembly is required.




The bed cover latch assembly comes from the factory only partially tightened to allow for installation adjustments. **Only use the hand tools provided, do not use power tools.** 

Lower the rear of the bed cover and adjust the position of each latch so that they engage with the striker brackets, (**Fig. 1**). With the latches adjusted, from underneath the cover, use the provided T-20 Torx wrench to tighten the two screws, (**Fig. 2**) so the latch does not move in the channel. Repeat on the other side.


Rotate the actuator knob until you see the flat head screws. Tighten the two screws using the provided 2.5mm hex wrench, (Fig. 3).


The cable comes routed through the barrel clamp and hangs out. Insert the cable through the middle of the passenger side of the actuator assembly. On the driver's side of the actuator, leave 3/4" - 1" (19.1 - 25.4mm) of cable extending through the barrel clamp, for future adjustments, (Fig. 3) so the knob does not move in the channel. Repeat on the other side.




Next, tighten the actuator mechanism set screws, (Fig. 4) with the provided 2.5mm hex key to secure the latch cables. Rotate the actuator knob, (Fig. 4) to verify that the latches disengage from the striker brackets.

Double-check that the cover is secure and tight to the truck bed by gently lifting the corners to ensure the mechanisms are engaged.








### Securing the cover

To drive with the cover open, fold the cover forward to the cab and fasten BOTH straps in the middle section to the front rail. Check that the straps are tight, and pull the strap end if too loose.



# **MIMPORTANT**

Re-tighten the front/cab clamps and tethers after the first week of driving the vehicle. Also periodically check the clamps and tethers to ensure they are secure.

Closed/Extended Position - Bed cover must be completely secured by all four (4) clamps.

**Open/Folded Position** – Bed cover must be completely folded up (all panels) and secured at the cab with the provided buckles straps and with both tethers attached.

**Do NOT** drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.







# **LIMITED WARRANTY**

#### **WARRANTY COVERAGE**

This truck bed cover is warrantied against defects in materials or workmanship as follows. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged in an accident, or due to neglect, unforeseeable use, improper installation, improper servicing, or other cause not arising out of defects in material or workmanship.

The truck bed cover carries a limited warranty for five (5) years from the original date of purchase, subject to the terms below.

#### **WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE**

The warranty is to the initial owner purchasing the truck bed cover and it is not transferrable to a subsequent end user. Proof of purchase may be required to enforce these warranty rights.

#### **WARRANTY CONDITIONS**

Failure to follow these care and use instructions will void the warranty.

- Clean with mild automotive soap and water only.
- Cover must be secured at all points when vehicle is in motion. When not fully extended, cover must be completely folded up and secured at the cab with the provided buckle straps and tethers attached. Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.
- Check all clamps and retention mechanisms for tightness after a week of driving following installation (or re-installation) of the cover and periodically thereafter.
- Before opening, cover must be free of all foreign materials including snow and ice.
- Do NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.

#### **WARRANTY PERFORMANCE**

If all warranty conditions are met, a defective truck bed cover or hardware component will either be repaired or replaced (at our option). We reserve the right, for any warranty, to substitute a newer model or bed cover having similar form and function, to offer a warranty discount on an entire replacement system, and/or provide remedies other than those mentioned in this document.

#### **WARRANTY PROCESS**

A Return Authorization number must be obtained from our Customer Service Department prior to returning any product. We may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. Other than postage or shipping charges, no charge will be made for repair or replacement under this warranty.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. As an owner, you may also have additional rights and remedies under the laws of your state.

#### **WARRANTY REGISTRATION**

Warranty registration must be on file and/or proof of original purchase (detailed and dated receipt) required for warranty to be effective.


