



Brackets must be configured for Passenger or Driver-Side as shown.








Using a 15mm Socket assemble Lateral mount onto Linkage assembly. Torque bolts to 20 ft-lbs. Note: Drivers side shown. Mirror for passenger side(See image in step 1 for passenger orientation).















Locate forward most bed channel. Insert Threaded Plate into Bed Channel. Jog in bracket must match jog in Bed Channel. (Driver Side Shown)




Locate the step pad on the center position of the lower linkage assembly and secure using provided PT Screws. Tighten to 5 ft-lbs using T25 Torx bit. Align Step pad to be in line with fender.




Torque bolts from Steps 3 and 5 to 20 ft-lbs.




Using a 15mm socket with extension, align bolt with threaded plate. Do not tighten.



Using a 15mm socket with extension, align bolt with threaded plate. Torque to 20 ft-lbs.




For 2011 - up Short bed models: Using a 15mm socket remove four bolts holding factory bracket in place. The two rear most U clips will need to be removed in step 10. For all other models skip to step 10.




For 2011 - up Short bed models: Remove the two rearmost u clips off the bracket and change orientation of the bolt so that the bolt head is on the outside of the bracket. Torque bolts to 16 ft-lbs.



For 2011 - up Short bed models : Attach bracket to threaded hole in frame mount. Rotate bracket up to position and use provided M12 Hardware. Tighten M8 bolt to 16 ft-lbs and M12 bolt to 35 ft-lbs.




For all other Models: Attach bracket to threaded hole in frame mount. Rotate bracket into position and use the provided M12 hardware.




NOTE:If a hole is not provided on a factory body mount, a hole must be drilled using a 1/2" drill bit.

For all other Models: Using 19mm socket, tighten bolt to 35 ft-lbs. Tighten M8 screw from step 9 to 16 ft-lbs




To deploy the step, press down using your foot on the outside edge of the step pad.



To retract, gently kick up on the underside of the step pad.

#### **OPERATION**

- The AMP Research BedStep® is foot operated and deploys and retracts with a nudge of your foot.
- To deploy, press down using your left foot, on the forward outside corner of the step pad.
- To retract, gently kick the underside of the step pad.
- Max Load Capacity: 300lbs.
- Always use appropriate hand holds when stepping up to or down from your truck's cargo bed.

#### **MAINTENANCE TIPS**

The step pad surface and linkage arms can be washed with mild soap and water using a soft brush or sponge to dislodge any mud, dirt or accumulated road grime. Rinse with fresh water.

To prevent slipping, avoid applying waxes, lubricants or protectants like Armor All® to the step surface.

BEDSTEP SHOULD ALWAYS BE STOWED IN THE RETRACTED POSITION WHEN DRIVING.
