Instructions:

- Approximated installation time: 30 min.
- 1. Read and understand instructions completely before beginning installation.
- 2. Sidebar set consist of a driver and passenger side. Be sure to determinate the correct side before installation.
- 3. Thread the 7/16 x 1 1/2" hex coupling nut onto the front body mount and torque it to 40 ft./lbs. Place the spacer tube over the front body mount coupling nut and insert the 7/16 x 1" hex head bolt with 7/16" lock washer and 7/16" flat washer up through the hole in the front mounting bracket.
- 4. Place the rear mounting bracket with flat face up and secure it to the frame using a 3/8 x 1" hex head bolts, flat and lock washers, and hex nuts. Hand tighten them.
- 5. Place the sidebar up to the mounting brackets and bolt to the mounting brackets using the 1/2 x 1 1/2" hex head bolt, flat and lock
- 6. Hook the auxiliary mounting bracket over the top of the frame and attach it to the sidebar using a 3/8 x 4" hex head bolt with lock, flat washer and nut. Note: To install this bracket on passenger side of the vehicle it may be necessary to push the fuel vent line, located on the outboard side of the frame.


- 7. Make any final adjustments to the alignment of the sidebar and tighten all bolts. Repeat for the opposite side.
- 8. You may need to re-tighten the bolts periodically.
