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





Protect the finish with a non-abrasive automotive wax, (e.g. Pure Carnauba) on a regular basis. The use of any soap, polish, or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental to the finish, as the compounds scratch the finish and cause

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- 5. Align paper path to the edges shown at picture 2, mark area to cut out and proceed. Repeat for opposite side.
- a).- Once openings were made, place tab bolts into the frame as shown at picture 3. Use the wire guide to place 1/2" rod bolts.
- 6. Identifies auxiliary bracket to install (See illustration 1) and attach with the same bolts of main bracket. See illustration 6 or 4. Leave loose.
- **7.** Place bull Bar Sport to the main brackets and auxiliary brackets and attach with: (1) 1/2 x 2" hex head bolt, (1) 1/2" flat and lock washers. By each bracket. Leave loose. **See illustration 2.**
- 8. Align the sidebar to the vehicle and tighten all hardware.
- 9. Repeat for the other side of vehicle.
- **10.** Fill out the warranty card included and place it inside your vehicle.



