Installation difficulty levels are based on time and effort involved and may vary depending on the installer level of expertise, condition of the vehicle and proper tools and equipment.



Torque Specifications M8 bolt 30 ft-lbs.

Mild automotive detergent may be used to clean the product. Do not use dish detergent, abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, wire brushes or other similar products that may damage the finish.

Step 1

Starting on the driver side, remove all M8 flange nuts from the M8 factory-threaded studs to remove the OE running boards.

Repeat on the passenger side of the vehicle.



Step 2

On the inside rocker panel there will be three attachment points consisting of three M8 studs coming out from the panel. Clean off any paint or debris from the studs before continuing the installation.



Step 3

Note: An additional person is recommended for this step.

Carefully install the running step to the three factory attachment points using the provided M8 hex flanged nuts. Leave the hardware loose at this time.



Step 4

Next, adjust the running step level with the body of the cab and tighten all three M8 flange nuts to the recommended torque specifications listed on page 1.

Step 7

Repeat steps 2 through 4 on the passenger side of the vehicle.
