REMOVAL

- 1. Disconnect the factory fog lights if equipped.
- 2. Remove the upper inter-cooler bolts using a 10mm socket and ratchet.
- 3. While supporting the bumper, remove the 4 nuts and bolts that fasten the bumper to the frame rail (Image 1) Note: the inter-cooler must be lifted in order to remove the bolt plates.
- 4. Remove the factory bumper.
- 5. Reinstall the 2 upper inter-cooler bolts.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Install the frame brackets to the frame rails with the angled portion of the bracket facing upward and the long side of the bracket facing inward (Image 2).
- 2. Use the factory bolt plates to attach the brackets to the frame facing the bolts inward, leaving hardware loose.
- 3. Install the intermediate brackets to the bumper using 6 1/2" x 3 1/2" bolts and 1/2" nuts, the long side of the bracket and the bolts should face outwards.
- 4. Lift the bumper and position it on the truck by lining up the holes on the intermediate brackets with the holes on the frame brackets, loosely install the 8 1/2" x 1 1/2" bolts and 1/2" nuts.
- 5. Adjust the bumper to achieve proper alignment.
- 6. Tighten all hardware.

NOTE: Install winch and roller fairlead prior to installing bumper on to truck, if installing a winch.
